

Assembly Instructions

Great Bay Dining and Bar Tables


Tools Needed: hammer, 7/16" wrench, #2 square bit screw driver or power driver, punch No drilling is required. All the necessary holes are predrilled. Bolts fit snugly in the holes. You may need to use a hammer to drive the bolts through the holes.

43" x **43"** and **43"** x **60"** Hardware List: twenty 2½" screws, twenty 2" screws

43" x 72" and 43" x 96" Hardware List: twenty-four 21/2" screws, thirty-eight 2" screws



Parts



Lay the table top upside down on a protected surface such as cardboard or blankets.

Step 1 — Fasten Brace

2" Screws, Brace Assembly, Legs





Match the numbers on the brace assembly to the numbers on the legs. Fasten the brace assembly to the legs using 2" screws in the pilot holes.

Step 2 — Fasten Leg

21/2" Screws, Leg Assembly





Center leg assembly on the tabletop. Fasten using 2½" screws using the pilot holes in the legs.

Step 3 — Fasten Skirt Boards

2" Screws, Tabletop Assembly, Legs, Skirt Boards







Use 2" screws in the pilot holes in the skirt board to fasten it to the legs. Place 2" screws in the pilot holes on each end of the skirt board to secure it to the tabletop.

Step 4 — Fasten Braces

21/2" Screws, Braces



Secure each brace using two 2½" screws in the pilot holes in the legs and one 21/2" screw in the pilot hole in the brace to secure it to the tabletop.
